Description of the institution

Volodymyr Dahl East Ukrainian National University (EUNU) is one of the leading higher education institutions in Ukraine. It was founded in 1920. The university had branches in other Ukrainian cities: Severodonetsk, Rubizhne, Krasnodon, Antratsyt, Livadiya, Feodosiya, Yevpatoriya, Skadovsk. In September 2014 the university was relocated from Luhansk (Donbas's Region) to Severodonetsk because of the military actions.

Nowadays the university has 14 faculties and nearly 7000 students, offers educational programs: Economics of Enterprise; Management; Ecology, Environmental Protection and Conservation of Nature; Computer Sciences; Mechanical Engineering; Electrical Engineering and Electrotechnology; Chemical Technology; Construction; Transport Technologies and others.
