Call for evaluators

The British Council in Ukraine is looking for experts and experienced practitioners in the field of culture and creative economy for evaluation of grant applications.

Overview of the British Council

The British Council is a legal entity created and existing in the form of a charity organization under the laws of England. The British Council works with governments and our partners in education, English language and cultural sectors, in the UK and globally.

Working together, the British Council is making a difference, creating benefits for millions of people all over the world. The British Council works in more than 100 countries around the world.

In Ukraine, the British Council acts as a cultural centre in accordance with the Agreement signed on February 10, 1993 between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Ukraine "On Cooperation in the Field of Education, Science and Culture".

Description of required services

The British Council is looking for experts and experienced practitioners in the field of culture and creative economy to effectively implement grant programmes in Ukraine in 2025-2027. The main task of the evaluators will be to assist with a transparent and impartial assessment of grant applications to select the strongest projects that will develop relationships between cultural organisations and individuals from Ukraine and the UK, as well as support the creative economy of Ukraine.

Key grant programmes:

1. [Cultural Activity in Ukraine with UK Involvement](#) evaluation of grant applications from the Ukrainian non-profit cultural organisations that implement public programmes in Ukraine involving content, artists or experts from the UK.
2. [Connections through Culture](#) assess applications for grants that support artistic cooperation between the UK and Ukraine. The programme funds joint projects of artists, creative professionals or arts organisations, promoting cross-cultural exchange and creating lasting partnerships.
3. [Creative Economy Development](#) evaluation of grant applications supporting creative hubs and industry associations. The programme funds the formation of a sustainable ecosystem and promotes the cohesion of representatives of culture and creative industries.

Fee: fixed rate for all evaluators within the framework of the competition, the final payment amount will depend on the number of evaluated grant applications. Candidates are required to be registered as private entrepreneurs (ФОП).

Requirements

- A minimum of five years of professional experience in the field of culture and creative economy within Ukraine.
- At least five years of proven experience in project management.
- Strong time management skills with a demonstrated ability to meet strict deadlines.
- Demonstrated trustworthiness, diligence, and a strong sense of professional responsibility.
- Excellent proficiency in English and Ukrainian.
- Prior experience working with international funding bodies is considered an advantage.
- Experience as a grants evaluator will be regarded as an advantage.

Please note that evaluators are not eligible to apply for any grant programmes of the British Council Ukraine, in order to avoid a conflict of interest. This restriction also applies to any organisations with which they are affiliated.
