Description of the institution
<p>Volodymyr Dahl East Ukrainian National University (EUNU) is one of the leading higher education institutions in Ukraine. It was founded in 1920. The university had branches in other Ukrainian cities: Severodonetsk, Rubizhne, Krasnodon, Antratsyt, Livadiya, Feodosiya, Yevpatoriya, Skadovsk. In September 2014 the university was relocated from Luhansk (Donbas's Region) to Severodonetsk because of the military actions.</p> <p>Nowadays the university has 14 faculties and nearly 7000 students, offers educational programs: Economics of Enterprise; Management; Ecology, Environmental Protection and Conservation of Nature; Computer Sciences; Mechanical Engineering; Electrical Engineering and Electrotechnology; Chemical Technology; Construction; Transport Technologies and others.</p>
